Itinerary:

Day 1. Malaga / Granada

Departure by our comfortable car from the meeting point to Granada (130km). Arrival at hotel and check in. In the afternoon, depart to the Scaramonte at the famous quarter of Albaizin to enjoy of one the best and traditionalist Flamenco in Spain. **Overnight in Granada.**

Day 2. Granada

Breakfast at hotel. Depart to visit the highlight of the south “La Alhambra”. Free afternoon to enjoy the famous down town of Granada: Calle Recogidas, Plaza del Carmen, City Hall, Cathedral, Madrasa, Arab Bazar, Plaza de reina Isabel, Plaza Nueva and the famous street of Elvira.

Overnight in Granada.

Day 3. Granada / Cordoba / Sevilla

Breakfast at hotel. Depart to Cordoba by our comfortable car (200km). Arrival and visit the Cathedral/ Mosque of Cordoba. Free time to enjoy the old town of “Judería” and take nice pictures from the Roman bridge. Then we will continue to Sevilla (140km). Arrival at the hotel and check in. **Overnight in Sevilla.**

Day 4. Sevilla / Malaga

Breakfast at hotel. Depart to make a panoramic tour: Plaza España, Universidad, Palace of San Telmo, Historical hotel Alfonso XIII, Alcazar, Park María Luisa. Free time for pictures and then we will depart back by our comfortable car to Malaga (209km). Arrival and end of our services.
